Code of Conduct

Welcome to the Dimond Center. We strive to provide an enjoyable and safe environment for everyone. The Center, including the parking area, is private property. This Code of Conduct is in effect at all times while visiting the Center. Permission is granted to tenants, employees, and customers to remain on property during normal business hours. In order to make your visit – and that of your fellow guests – a pleasant one, we require everyone to observe the following rules. Persons violating this Code of Conduct will be asked to leave the Center and/or be subject to trespass with the possibility of being arrested for violating trespass, or violating Anchorage Municipal Code or Alaska State Law.

The following are prohibited:

1. Relocating or misusing Dimond Center furniture, property or amenities.
2. Use or possession of a controlled substance, including marijuana. The use of tobacco products, including E-cigarettes or other electronic smoking devices, except in their designated areas.
3. Possession of open alcoholic beverages except in designated areas.
4. Loitering, solicitation and inebriation.
5. Entering authorized personnel only areas and the use of common area electrical outlets.
6. Wheeled modes of transportation in areas designated for walking persons.
7. Animals, with the exception of ADA designated service animals.
8. Creating a disruption or commotion that could be construed as a disturbance of the peace and the use of obscene or offensive language.
9. The failure to wear appropriate clothing, and disguises of any kind, to include any gang affiliated garments or apparel.
10. Using handrails, stairs, escalators, planters, benches and trash receptacles for other than their intended purpose.
11. The possession of firearms or anything else that could be construed to be a weapon.
12. The use of photography/videography.
13. Overnight parking or the use of the parking lot for the sale of vehicles.
